

# Requirements 101 Workshop for Agile Teams

This 1-2 day onsite interactive workshop is for teams looking to improve how they collect, write and manage requirements in an Agile process. It is useful for practitioners and managers to understand leading practices for writing effective Epics, User Stories and other agile artifacts.

## Benefits

- Improve consistency and quality of requirements by providing teams with foundational skills in collecting and authoring requirements in Agile process
- Improve communication of requirements with various product and business stakeholders

## Agenda (can be structured in one or two-day format)

- 30 min: Introduction, agenda and general housekeeping
  - Exercise: survey or test to understand current state of team
- 30 min: Why agile: Fail story + Agile manifesto
  - Exercise & discussion: Manifesto
- 1 hour: Agile principles
  - Incremental delivery
  - Exercise: Feature delivery chart
  - Work in progress limits and batch sizes
  - Exercise: Penny batch game
- 1 hour: Agile methods (focus on SCRUM)
  - Principles vs. Methods
  - Agile team roles
  - Agile terms & taxonomy (e.g. Story, Feature, Epic, Sprint, etc.)
  - Requirements: Samples of epic vs. feature vs user story
  - Releases vs. Iterations vs. Springs
- Lunch Break
- 1 hour: Sprint activities
  - Backlog, prioritization, development, demos
  - Continuous feedback – standups and retrospectives

- 30 min: Eliciting requirements
  - Discussion on different methods
  - Exercise: Stakeholder Interview
- 1 hour, 30 min:
  - Exercise: Writing agile requirements
  - Teams pick a new product or software and write 1 epic
  - Teams decompose into features
  - Teams decompose into User stories & acceptance criteria
  - Teams review and provide feedback to each other
- 30min: Conclusion - takeaways and recap
  - Closing survey/test
